

## OLEEVIA FOUNDATION'S FREE MEDICAL CAMP: A COLLABORATIVE SUCCESS IN AMBALAPARA



The Oleevia Foundation, in collaboration with K Karunakaran Charitable Trust and Rotary, organized a highly successful free medical camp for the people of Ambalapara, Ottappalam in Palakkad on August 29 and 30, 2024. The camp witnessed an overwhelming response from local residents, reflecting the pressing need for accessible medical care in the region.
